This year we will provide around **1,000 emergency food parcels** to individuals and families in need in South Derbyshire.

The festive season can be particularly difficult for people experiencing financial hardship – so our help and support is crucial at this time.

That’s why we’re appealing for **financial donations** to help feed families across South Derbyshire who are struggling. This can be for all kinds of reasons - ill-health, job loss, bereavement, homelessness or other changes in personal circumstances.



Big or small, a gift from you will help us make sure no-one in South Derbyshire goes hungry this Christmas.

**£5 provides an emergency parcel for a child for 1 day**  
**£20 feeds a family for 3 days**  
**£50 feeds a family for a week**

We receive many generous food donations from local people and businesses, and support from our team of busy volunteers who sort, pack and give out the parcels. However financial donations help us to buy extra supplies when we run short of particular items, and to cover essential running costs, such as storage, volunteer expenses and the wages of our coordinator to organise the team of volunteers and help Food Bank users get the support they need to get back on their feet.
